

## **Legislative Update**

Effective Jan. 1, 2010, the Quality Jobs Through Renewable Energy Act
passed provides qualifying renewable-energy employers an incentive
equal to 10 percent of what they spend on building a new manufacturing
operation or corporate office in the state. In November 2009, Chinese
concern Suntech Power Holdings was the first to take advantage of the

law, with a 75-person manufacturing plant in Greater Phoenix.

- A 24-month moratorium on municipal development fees was signed into law in September 2009.
- Expedited plan review and fee reimbursements are now available on a graded scale from the City of Chandler for LEED-certified projects.
