

Legislative Update

- In November, the state launched a new site certification program, the California Air Resources Board released a draft of the nation's first cap-andtrade program, and an \$11-billion water infrastructure plan was passed.
- The state insurance commissioner twice rejected a request to raise the workers' compensation rate.
- Effective April 1, 2009, California's minimum sales tax increased to 8.25

percent.

- The Commission on the 21st Century Economy (www.cotce.ca.gov) submitted its recommendations to improve the state's tax system.
- In October, 34 recipients divided \$27 million in grants in the first phase of the California Clean Energy Workforce Training Program (CEWTP), the largest state-sponsored green jobs training program in the nation.
