

Legislative Update

- A new law extends tax credits to those who convert vehicles to compressed natural gas or hybrid electric, phases out tax credits for hybrids with lower fuel economy and allows low-speed electric vehicles to operate on more roads.
- Sales tax refunds were renewed and expanded for bioscience and

- clean-tech companies that purchase equipment used in R&D for new technologies and products.
- A new job creation incentive provides a corporate income-tax credit of up to half of a relocating company's annual FICA taxes on new workers, a tax credit for angel investors and a grant program for clean tech R&D.
