

Legislative Update

- Under certain limits, a new law allows any taxing district to abate any portion of property tax if a new business first occupies a facility located on a property during the taxable year, and the facility was vacant for a period of at least 24 continuous months prior to being occupied.
- The Intermodal Facilities Promotion Act was signed into law (see p. 91).
- The Illinois Enterprise Zone Act was amended so that businesses
- that intend to establish a new wind power facility in the state may be considered high-impact businesses and qualify for certain occupation tax exemptions.
- Under a new law, LEED and Green Globes certification costs have been added as valid "Redevelopment Project Costs" that can be funded by the Illinois Tax Increment Fund.
