

Legislative Update

- lowa expanded its historic tax credit program for historic renovation from \$20 million to \$50 million, \$10 million of which must be used on projects that will create 500 or more jobs.
- The I-JOBS program was created to with \$830 to invest in the state's infrastructure. This includes \$115 for transportation projects, \$115 million for state university construction and \$165 for continuing flood recovery and rebuilding.
