

Legislative Update

 The EnCap Reform bill was passed, requiring businesses receiving any combination of financial assistance totaling more than \$50 million to file annual, independently audited financial statements with the State Treasurer as well as each entity from which financing was secured. For any qualifying contract, the bill specifies that 1) the private business spend a minimum of \$1 for every \$5 received in public funds; 2) the public entity reserve 10 percent of the total funds approved to be disbursed upon the successful completion of the project; and 3) the private business submit payment of a performance bond, the amount of which would be tied to the project costs attributable to the publicly funded improvements.
