

## **Legislative Update**

- Gov. Phil Bredesen signed into law the Tennessee Clean Energy Future Act of 2009. Among other changes, the Clean Energy Future Act requires state government to do a better job "leading by example" in managing its buildings and vehicle fleet; and makes the clean-energy technology sector eligible for Tennessee's emerging industry tax credit.
- Highlights of the 2009-2010 budget include fully funding the Basic

Education Program, the state's funding formula for K-12 education; fully funding economic development projects currently under way, including Wacker Chemie AG, Hemlock Semiconductor and Volkswagen Group of America; and providing for development of the Haywood County megasite in West Tennessee, including a fivemegawatt 20-acre demonstration solar farm.
