


## **Legislative Update**

• Gov. Rick Perry signed House Bill (HB) 4765 which lowers the tax burden for more than 40,000 small businesses across the state. The bill more than triples the small business franchise tax exemption from \$300,000 to \$1 million. The bill modifies the franchise tax legislation passed by lawmakers in 2006, which was determined to have a disproportionate impact on small businesses making between the

original \$300,000 revenue cap and \$1 million per year.

• HB 51 is a higher education bill that establishes measures to enhance and maintain the quality of the state's designated and emerging public research universities; creates incentive programs and funding for higher education institutions; provides higher education fund allocations; and creates an interim committee to study the feasibility of tracking specialized technology research projects.
