

Legislative Update

- Gov. Chris Gregoire signed House Bill 1906 in February, which will give Washingtonians receiving unemployment insurance an additional \$45 a week in benefits, coming at the same time the federal government is increasing benefits by \$25 a week. The combined state and federal increases will mean \$70 more a week for Washingtonians on unemployment.
- The state economic and community development agency was renamed the Dept. of Commerce and re-tasked to maintain a focus on jobs and economic development. Restructuring recommendations were submitted to Gov. Gregoire and the legislature in November 2009.
- A measure passed ensuring that land-use planning allows major ports to thrive
