



## **Legislative Update**

- Pension reform was signed into law in October which officials estimate will save the state \$100 billion over the coming decades.
- The Legislature approved a bill which will put a constitutional amendment on the state's presidential primary ballot in 2012 that would strengthen the state's rainy day fund.
- The state provided \$19 million for Green Innovation Challenge Grants to help train nearly 3,000 people in green and clean industries.
- In July, the state reported that the California Film & Television Tax Credit Program, enacted in 2009, has helped bring \$2 billion in direct spending to the state.
