

Legislative Update

- The state's Renewable Portfolio Standard was expanded so that 25 percent of Delaware's electricity must come from renewable energy sources by the year 2025. This includes solar energy targets and provides incentives for local labor and manufacture of renewable energy systems.
- Delaware's Green Energy Fund was updated to address a backlog of projects awaiting incentive funds.
- The state's net metering law was strengthened by increasing the amount
 of energy customers can sell back to their electric supply grid to 110
 percent of their aggregate consumption to the grid. Customers such as a
 business campus or agricultural operations can aggregate several meters
 for multiple locations to determine how much power can be sold back
 through one meter.
