Did You know?

• The Manufacturing and Spaceport Incentive encourages capital investment and job creation in manufacturing and spaceport activities in Florida. The Florida Legislature has authorized the provision of a sales tax refund to an eligible entity on its purchases of eligible equipment placed into service in Florida in excess of the entity's base year purchases. The program began on July 1, 2010, and ends on June 30, 2012. Only the State sales and use taxes paid on equipment purchases which are in excess of a company's Base Year Purchases are eligible for the tax refund. Also, U.S. Sen. Bill Nelson wants to create five business enterprise zones around the country, including one possibly at the Kennedy Space Center, where investors who put their money in commercial space ventures would get major tax breaks.

Legislative Update

- A bill expands the use of Florida's existing business incentives and provides \$22 million to support economic development. It includes \$15 million in additional funding for the Quick Action Closing Fund (QAC).
- Also receiving continued funding is the Qualified Target Industry Tax Refund (QTI). Additional per-job tax refunds will be provided for highimpact businesses, for businesses receiving exceptional support from

a local government, and for businesses that increase exports of goods through Florida seaports or airports. Also receiving funding is the High Impact Performance Incentive Grant program. The eligibility threshold for is lowered from a \$100-million investment and 100 jobs to \$50 million and 50 new jobs. The qualifying amount required for R&D facilities also changes from \$75 million and 75 jobs, to \$25 million and 25 new jobs.
