

Legislative Update

- In May the legislature sent to Gov. Brad Henry a package of four workers' comp reform bills, all of which were signed into law. A full summary of all changes can be found at www.owcc.state.ok.us.
- HB 1786 will allow local governments engaged in economic development projects, including military growth impact, to capture the growth
- revenue relating to state sales tax collections for a period of five years to offset the direct cost of public infrastructure required to support the industrial or commercial development.
- The Oklahoma Quality Events Incentive Act assists municipalities and counties in promoting events which have a significant economic impact.
