



 According to a summary by law firm Foxley Pignanelli, Utah accepted a \$13-million federal grant to extend Internet/communication services to rural Utah. The number 13 also applied to other measures with mixed results: Charter schools were granted \$13 million for growth, and higher education received a 13-percent decrease in the base budget.
