



## **Legislative Update**

- The Acceleration Fund was created within the Arkansas Science and Technology Authority (ASTA) to assist various programs and efforts aimed at creating high-paying, technology oriented jobs.
- Effective July 1, 2011, the sales tax on energy used in manufacturing was reduced to 2.625 percent, with a \$27-million annual cap on revenue loss from this benefit. In addition, there is a graduated reduction on the sales
- tax on natural gas used in combined cycle gas turbines used to generate electricity.
- The Local Sales and Use Tax Economic Development Project Funding Act authorizes the levy of a local sales tax to fund economic development projects if preconditions are met.
