Legislative Update

The Alabama Commercial Aviation Business Improvement Act will help the state recruit more aerospace industry suppliers, expected to locate in the region as Airbus builds its first U.S.-based production facility in Mobile. The legislation, signed by Gov. Bentley in April 2013, levels the playing field between Alabama and nearby states in the recruitment of supplier companies. The Act applies to a small category

of lawsuits which involve manufacturers of commercial aircraft with 100 seats or more. Neighboring states already have similar laws in place. The bill will protect the rights of Alabama citizens to bring suit against manufacturers, but will also protect manufacturers from out-of-state and foreign plaintiffs who may seek to file suit in Alabama simply because the manufacturer located its plant here.
