

Legislative Update

- Legislators passed Senate Bill 21, the More Alaska Production Act, that cuts
 taxation on oil in order to spur production on the North Slope, which has been
 declining by 6 percent annually in recent years. Opponents of the measure were
 successful in forcing a referendum to repeal the Act, which will appear on the
 2014 primary ballot.
- New permitting legislation will give Alaskans more say over the permitting process. Lawmakers passed the governor's Interior Energy Plan, which will provide cheaper energy to the Interior and to road and river communities. And Senate Bill 23 puts in place a financing package for natural gas liquefaction on the North Slope and a distribution system, in conjunction with private-sector financing.
