Legislative Update

- Beginning in 2015, Rhode Island will have an Executive Office of Commerce. The newly-created Secretary of Commerce position will also function as CEO of the Rhode Island Commerce Corp., formerly the state's Economic Development Corp.
- In addition to signing a bill allowing same-sex marriage in Rhode Island, Governor Chafee also signed Temporary Caregiver Insurance (TCI) into law. Under TCI, work-

ers can take up to four weeks of leave from their job while caring for a sick family member or welcoming a new child.

 The legislature maintained the Enterprise Zone Tax Credit providing tax credits to businesses located in enterprise zones. Expansion of an enterprise zone in Pawtucket is credited for drawing a new company—and 240 jobs—into the city.
