## **Legislative Update**

- The South Dakota state government closed the 2013 budget year on June 30 with a surplus of \$24.2 million. The current Budget Reserve Fund total stands at \$95.3 million.
- Gov. Daugaard unveiled his FY2015 budget on Dec. 3, 2013. Among other measures, he asked for \$30 million for a one-time expenditure to pre-pay three

years of the Building South Dakota program, a comprehensive economic and community development package passed during the 2013 legislative session. Among the features are a Reinvestment Payment program, allowing companies with projects of \$20 million or higher to apply for a rebate of the 4 percent state sales tax, and a \$3.1 million Workforce and Education Fund.
