

Legislative Update

- In April 2013, Governor Tomblin signed sweeping education reform into law.
- HB 2508 increases the minimum capital investment threshold for sales tax increment financing (TIF) districts from more than \$25 million to more than \$75 million for county and municipal economic opportunity development districts.
- Senate Bill 103 created the West Virginia Commuter Rail Access Act. The new law
- allows for the state to enter into agreements with other states to provide commuter rail operation in states where commuter rail operation is already present.
- The Complete Street Act, SB 158, encourages the Division of Highways to use the latest and best design standards in developing bicycle, pedestrian, transit and highway facilities.
