Legislative Update

• Two pieces of legislation will create an estimated 33,000 new jobs and provide tax relief to nearly 1 million Minnesotans. The Minnesota Jobs Bill will invest \$1.17 billion in critical infrastructure projects across Minnesota and create tens of thousands of new jobs. The second provides an additional \$103 million in tax relief

to middle class families, farmers, veterans, small businesses and nonprofits.

• Another measure aims to significantly reduce the time it takes state government agencies to process environmental permits for job-creating projects.
