

Kentucky is taking the lead in the booming aluminum production industry. In 2014, aluminum contributed \$2 billion to the state's gross domestic product, and the industry employed more than 20,000 Kentuckians.

In 2014, Kentucky ranked fourth in the State Entrepreneurship Index (SEI), up 45 places from the previous year, and was the most improved state in the ranking. According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, Kentucky has the highest percentage growth of business establishments in the nation. The state also receives high marks from the Kauffman Foundation and Thumbtack.com for "small business friendliness."
