Legislative Update

- Lawmakers repealed Oklahoma's "double deduction" for state income taxes, as the legislature looked for new revenues to close a large budget deficit caused in large part by sluggish oil revenues. Repeal of the deduction is expected to raise \$87 million in 2017.
- · Lawmakers left most corporate tax breaks untouched, but cut the Earned Income Tax credit, a key income support for some low-wage workers.
- The legislature rejected SQ 779, a proposed state-wide sales tax to improve school funding.
