

Legislative Update

- Virginia's biennial budget includes almost \$20 million to strengthen the commonwealth's workforce development system. The infusion is meant to expand resources for skills development and apprenticeship programs.
- The budget also includes \$50 million to improve services at Dulles International Airport, plus a \$2.2 billion bond package, \$569 million of which is to go toward research and STEM projects at Virginia's colleges and universities.
- SB 437, signed by McAuliffe in July, is to help create pathways to employment in Virginia's healthcare fields for highly skilled medical veterans. Modeled on a program run by the US Dept. of Veterans' Affairs, the Virginia Military Medics and Corpsmen program is the first such statewide venture in the nation.


