



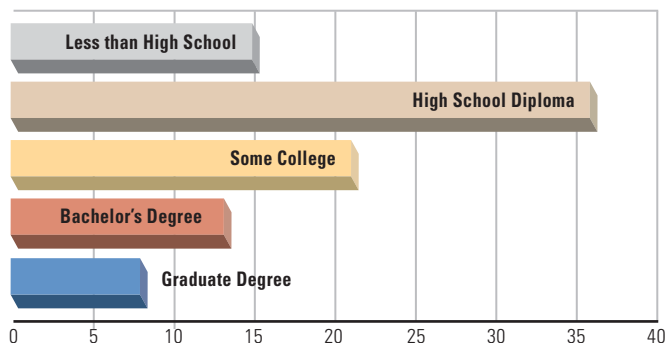

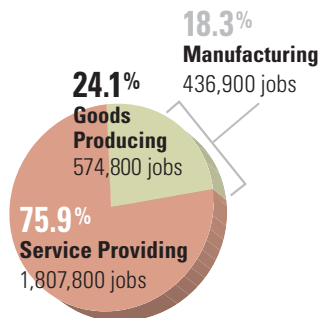

Did You Know?

- Indiana, at just over 22 percent, ranked No. 1 in the country by percentage of private-sector employment in manufacturing in 2007 (the most recent year for which data is available).
- According to Community College Week, the Indianapolis Campus of Ivy Tech Community College ranked second in the nation in enrollment growth among schools with an enrollment of 10,000 students or more,

as it experienced a 22.1 percent enrollment increase from Fall 2007 to Fall 2008. Fall 2009 enrollment there surpassed 21,501. Statewide enrollment on Ivy Tech's 23 campuses reached 109,358 students in fall 2009, an increase of 24.7 percent.

Legislative Update

- "All 40 of the bills the Indiana Chamber labeled as 'job killers' to start the session either met their demise or were altered to our satisfaction," read the final legislative report from the Indiana Chamber. In the state budget, reported the Chamber, the 21st Century Research and Technology Fund annual appropriation was cut in half to \$17.5 million. The Indiana Innovation Alliance and the Midwest Academy

of Nanoelectronics each receive \$10 million a year. And a regional transportation district authorized to receive local tax dollars is now established in Northwest Indiana. A new law gives local government the authority to grant personal property tax exemptions for IT equipment purchases of at least \$10 million — a measure thought to help the attraction of data centers.
