

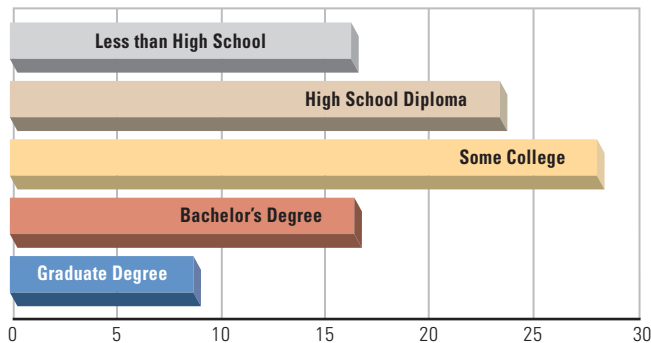

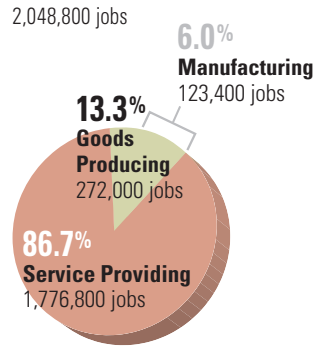

Did You Know?

- Maryland is home to the second highest concentration of professional and technical workers (25.4) among the states, and the highest proportion of doctoral scientists and engineers in the nation.
- Maryland has the fourth largest cluster of biotechnology companies in the U.S.

Legislative Update

- The legislature kept Maryland's Biotechnology Investment Tax Credit program at its full funding of \$6 million for FY10. The program encourages investors to provide seed and early-stage funding to qualified, privately held Maryland biotechnology companies.
- A bill was passed allowing certain counties and municipalities to finance the costs of infrastructure improvements located in or supporting a transit-oriented development (TOD), including the cost for operation and maintenance of infrastructure improvements.
