

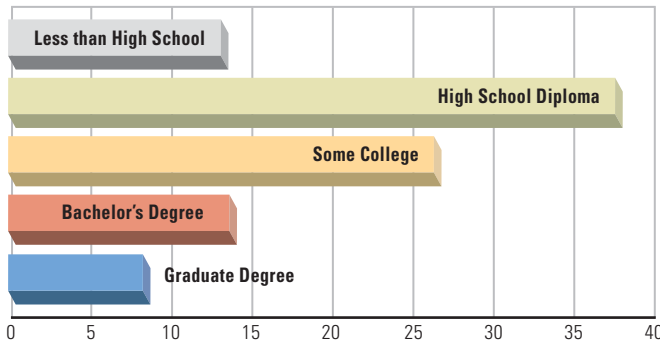

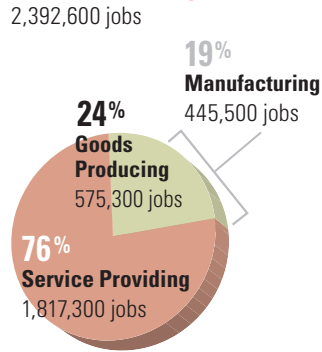

## Did You Know?

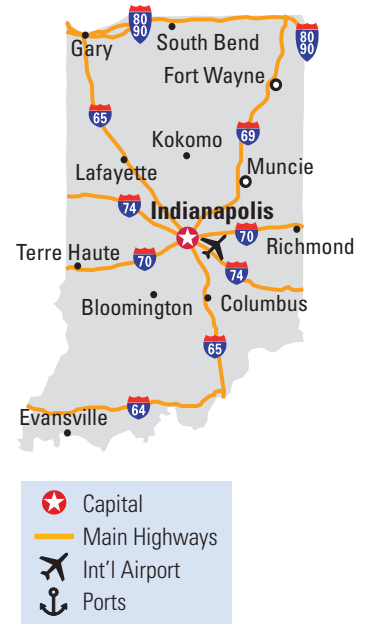
- That the Headquarters Relocation Tax Credit provides a tax credit to corporations that relocate their headquarters to Indiana. The credit equals half the moving costs and is assessed against the corporation's state tax liability. Indiana's Department of Revenue determines eligibility.
- The Media Production Sales Tax Exemption provides individuals and companies a credit of up to 15 percent on the amount spent in Indiana

for qualified production expenditures. Eligible expenses may include pre-production, production, and post-production expenses.

- The R&D sales tax exemption provides a refund of 50 percent of the Indiana sales taxes paid on purchases of eligible R&D equipment purchased after June 30, 2007. Taxpayers may also file a claim for the refund for tax paid on retail transactions that occur after June 30, 2005.

## Legislative Update

- Legislation passed that authorizes the Dept. of Agriculture to award grants from the agricultural biomass infrastructure grant fund (formerly E85 fueling station grant program) for certain infrastructures used for the production or distribution of biomass fuels. Animal byproducts and algae were added to the list of matter that is considered organic waste biomass for the purposes of "renewable energy resources."
- In November, Indiana voters approved a constitutional cap on property taxes. The cap, which had already been state law since 2008, limits property tax bills to 1 percent of the assessed value of homes, 2 percent for farms and rental properties and 3 percent for businesses.
- Lawmakers postponed making changes to the state's unemployment insurance tax.
