



Legislative Update

•The 61st state legislature passed laws in early 2011 that accomplished the following: imposition of sales tax on services and tangible personal property used within an oil or gas well site; extending the sunset for film industry financial incentives program through June 30, 2016; providing for additional sales and use tax exemptions for data processing services centers; transferring all department of employment programs and

functions to the department of new workforce services; extending the sales and use tax exemption for manufacturing equipment until Dec. 31, 2017; requiring new public notice and other transparency measures in the siting process for wind energy facilities; and establishment of a task force to study potential incentives and regulations to encourage nuclear energy production in Wyoming.
