



Legislative Update

- Gov. Bryant signed into law several components of his Mississippi Works agenda. The Health Care Industry Zone Act authorizes the establishment of "health care zones" throughout the state where significant acute-care facilities exist. Health care businesses like laboratory testing facilities, medical supply distributors and biotechnology research facilities that either make an investment of at least \$10 million or create a minimum of
- 25 full time, permanent jobs within the zone are eligible for certain tax incentives.
- Another bill creates relief for Mississippi businesses that pay inventory tax by making them eligible for tax credits against their state income tax liability.
- SB 2576 revises Mississippi's workers' compensation regulations.
