





Legislative Update

- Citing record redemptions of Missouri's 61 tax credit programs in Fiscal Year 2012, Gov. Nixon in August called upon the bipartisan Missouri Tax Credit Review Commission to update the original report it released in November 2010. Between fiscal years 2010 and 2012, redemptions of state tax credits increased 15.4 percent, setting an all-time record.
- A new law extends the expiration of the provisions regarding the sales

tax exemption on the sale of aviation jet fuel. Another clarifies that a small business formed as a sole proprietorship, partnership, S-corporation, C-corporation, limited liability company, limited liability partnership, or other business entity can qualify for the income tax deduction for job creation by a small business and allows any flow-through entity to pass the deduction on to its members, shareholders, or partners.
