- ConocoPhillips and BP provided written assurances they will commit to a process to make available their share of Alaska's North Slope gas to a future gas pipeline project. Because of this commitment, Gov. Walker said he would not introduce a bill during the Oct. 2015 special session proposing a property tax on gas leases within the Prudhoe Bay and Point Thomson units.
