Legislative Update

- The state increased the fuel tax by 10 cents per gallon. It was the first gas tax hike in 26 years.
 The \$200 million raised annually through the tax increase will go toward critically needed improvements on lowa's roads.
- The lowa Legislature also approved a base increase of 1.25 percent for K-12 school funding, plus an additional \$55.7 million in one-time spending.
- Though the lowa Senate approved a bill raising lowa's minimum wage to \$8.75 an hour – up from \$7.25 an hour – the legislation didn't make it out of the House of Representatives. The issue will likely be taken up in the next session.

lowa is a corporate headquarters mecca. The state is home to 140 insurance company headquarters alone, in addition to such companies as Hirschbach Motor Lines, Pella Windows and DuPont Pioneer.

According to the USDA, lowa leads the nation in production of corn, pork and eggs. The state is home to close to 90,000 farms, 97.5 percent of which are family-owned.

CNBC reports that lowa has the seventh lowest cost of doing business in the US. The state's insurance premium tax is one of the lowest in the nation – just 1 percent – and workers' compensation premiums rank 11 percent lower than the national average.
