

Legislative Update

- Assembly Bill 35 modified Nevada Revised Statutes to conform to national standards governing the regulation of insurance.
- Assembly Bill 482 removes restrictive language that prescribes
 the purposes for which Career and Technical Education
 grants may be awarded. The bill expands the flexibility of the
 Department of Education to award CTE grants to programs of
 instruction in emerging industries and better align Nevada's
 growing workforce with the jobs of the new Nevada economy.
- Assembly Bill 471 establishes the Office of Cyber Defense Coordination within the Dept. of Public Safety. It will function as the state's first Executive Branch Agency devoted entirely to cybersecurity efforts.
- AB 69 allows for testing and operations of fully autonomous vehicles, simplifies and clarifies the legal authority for entities testing or operating them, authorizes commercial use of fully autonomous vehicles and authorizes testing and operations of driver-assistive platooning technologies.
