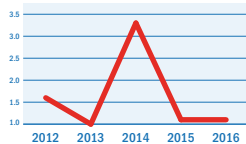

## Legislative Update

- As part of the biennium budget signed into law on July 1, The Ohio Enterprise Zone, which serves as an important economic development tool, was indefinitely extended. The program allows municipalities and counties to approve property tax incentives for eligible new investment made in conjunction with a business project that includes job creation.
- The state Senate in December passed legislation that would allow students the option to take an advanced computer science class in lieu of certain math and science classes.

## Did You Know?

In 2020 The Ohio State University will celebrate its sesquicentennial. The school has more than 66,000 students enrolled, and more than 550,000 living alumni. Key projects on the Columbus campus announced in November 2017 include a new arts district, an interdisciplinary research complex and new health sciences and medical center facilities.

Ohio manufacturers contributed \$108 billion to the economy in 2015, 17.8 percent of the total for the state.

In CompTIA's Cyberstates 2017 report, Ohio ranked 15th in the nation in tech sector employment, growing by nearly 3 percent in 2016 as employers added an estimated 5,000 new jobs to attain a total of nearly 184,000 workers.

Ohio's maritime ports and river terminals handle over 103 million tons of commodities valued at \$11 billion worth of cargo per year.

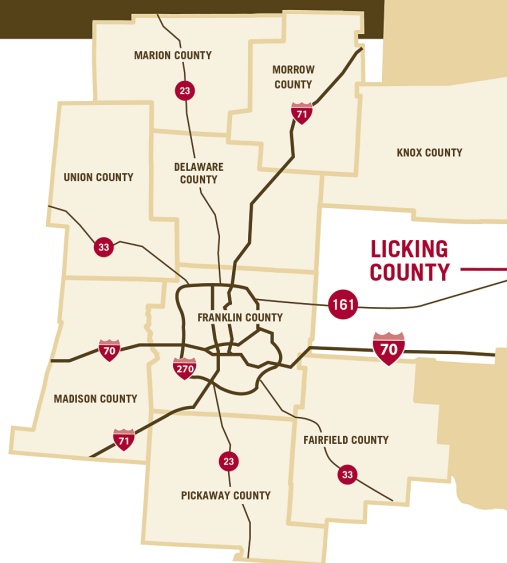
