- In June, Washington became the fifth state to adopt paid family leave: The Family and Medical Leave Insurance Program will provide up to 16 weeks of leave for those wanting to take time off to care for a new infant or care for a family member. Depending on their earnings, employees will receive up to 90 percent of their wage or salary or up to \$1,000 per week.
- The program will be implemented by 2020.
- In June, at the facility of Echodyne, a radar technology startup in Bellevue, Gov. Jay Inslee signed an executive order to support safe testing and operation of autonomous vehicles.
